The timeline of events in year 11 for the following

- ▶ Applying for sixth form
- ▶ Applying for college

These two options are full time education, Open Evenings are held in November and applications are made thereafter.

- ▶ Applying for an apprenticeship(s)

Big companies may start receiving applications in the autumn term.

We register pupils for apprenticeships in the Spring term and they may receive vacancies in the Spring and Summer terms.
