Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been a pleasure to watch Year 11 settle in so well to the start of their final GCSE year. They continue to impress us with their commitment and motivation to do their best.

We are of course mindful of the disruption to in-school learning that was faced by all of our students as a result of the pandemic. We are particularly focussed on supporting Year 11 as they work towards completing their GCSE examinations.

As a result we will be running compulsory intervention sessions after school (between 3pm and 4pm) starting from Monday 27th September, for some students. Attached to this email is a timetable showing which subjects will run sessions and on which days. The timetable is split into 'week 1' and 'week 2', to reflect your child's normal two week timetable.

Students may be invited to attend particular intervention sessions by their class teachers. If they are, they should attend after school on the relevant days. A lot of time goes into planning these additional sessions to ensure that students are in the best possible position for their GCSE examinations. If students are invited to attend intervention by their class teacher, their attendance is compulsory. The sanction for failing to attend is an L1 (30 minute lunchtime detention). We are confident that Year 11 will positively embrace this opportunity to spend more time with their subject teachers practicing the skills they will need in their exams and revising important subject content.
