



## What should I do when I am doing my school work from home?

**Show My Homework** – Teachers will be using SMHW to set all work to be completed remotely. This might be in the form of attached worksheets, online quizzes, links to other resources. Please use this as the main means of communication with your teacher about work that is required to be completed.

**School Email Accounts** – please use your school email account if you have any queries or questions that cannot be answered through SMHW.

### Seneca Learning

Your teachers may ask you to sign-up through SMHW which you can join via a code. Through the classes, teachers can set and receive work. You will require a school email address to join classes. You can join as an individual as well and sign up to each subject you study at school. For GCSE/A Level, you just need to know what exam board you are doing.
