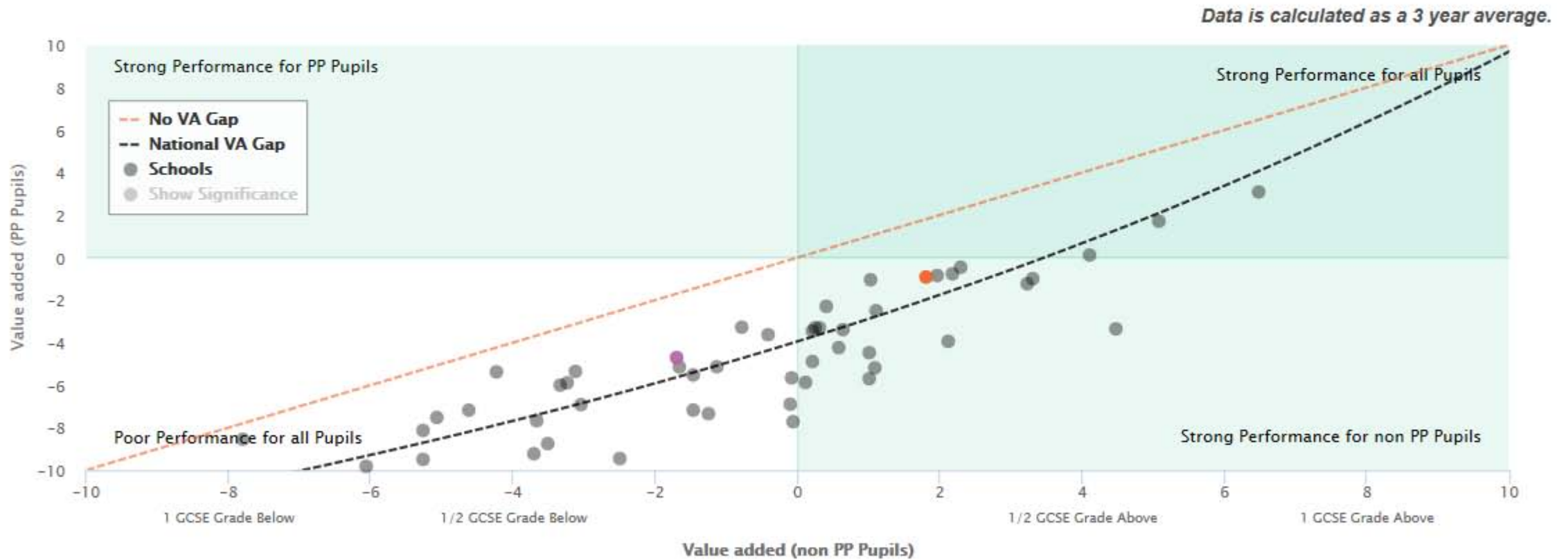


Value added in your Family

This shows how much progress the two groups of pupils make relative to each other. The black line shows the national average gap for value added. 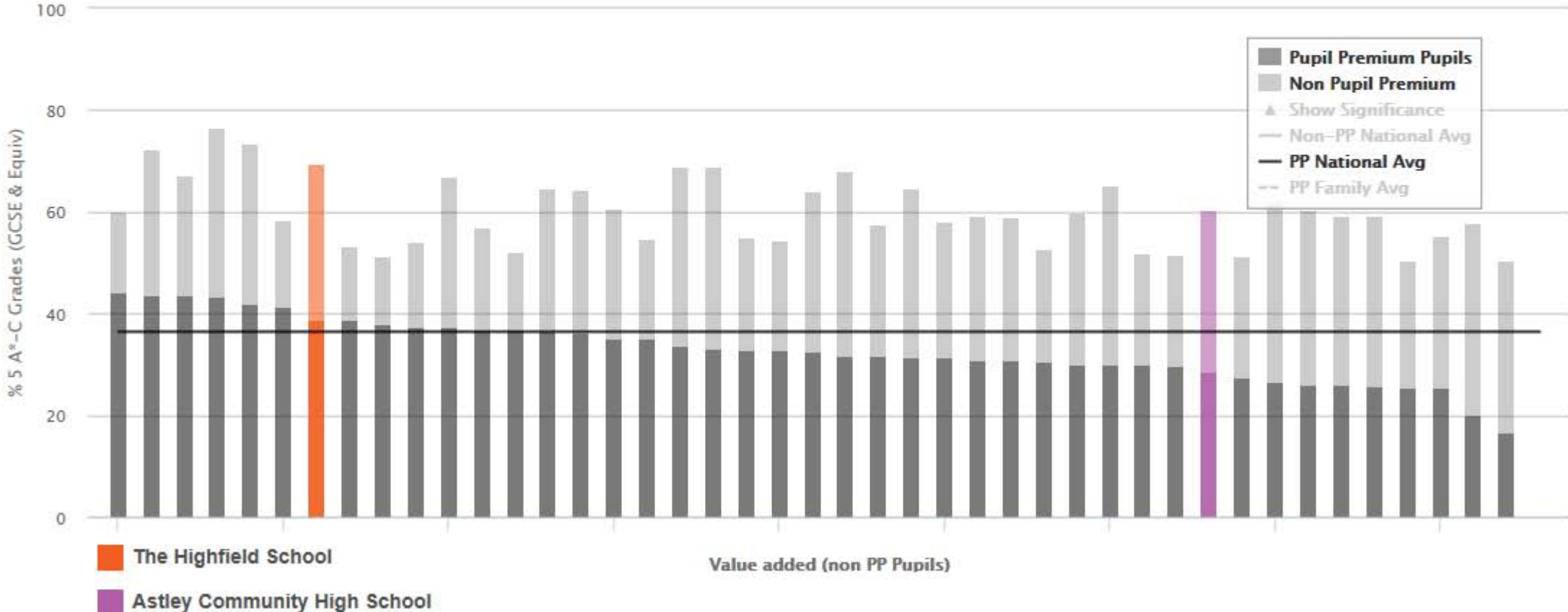

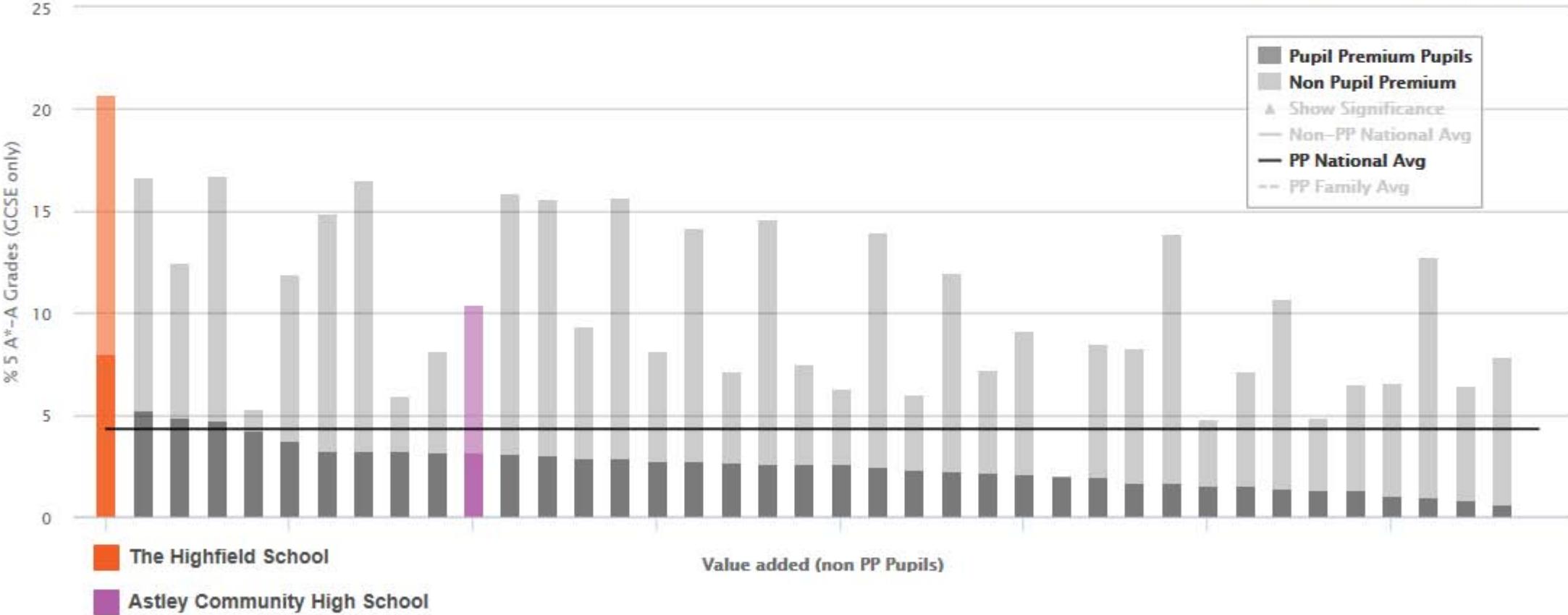

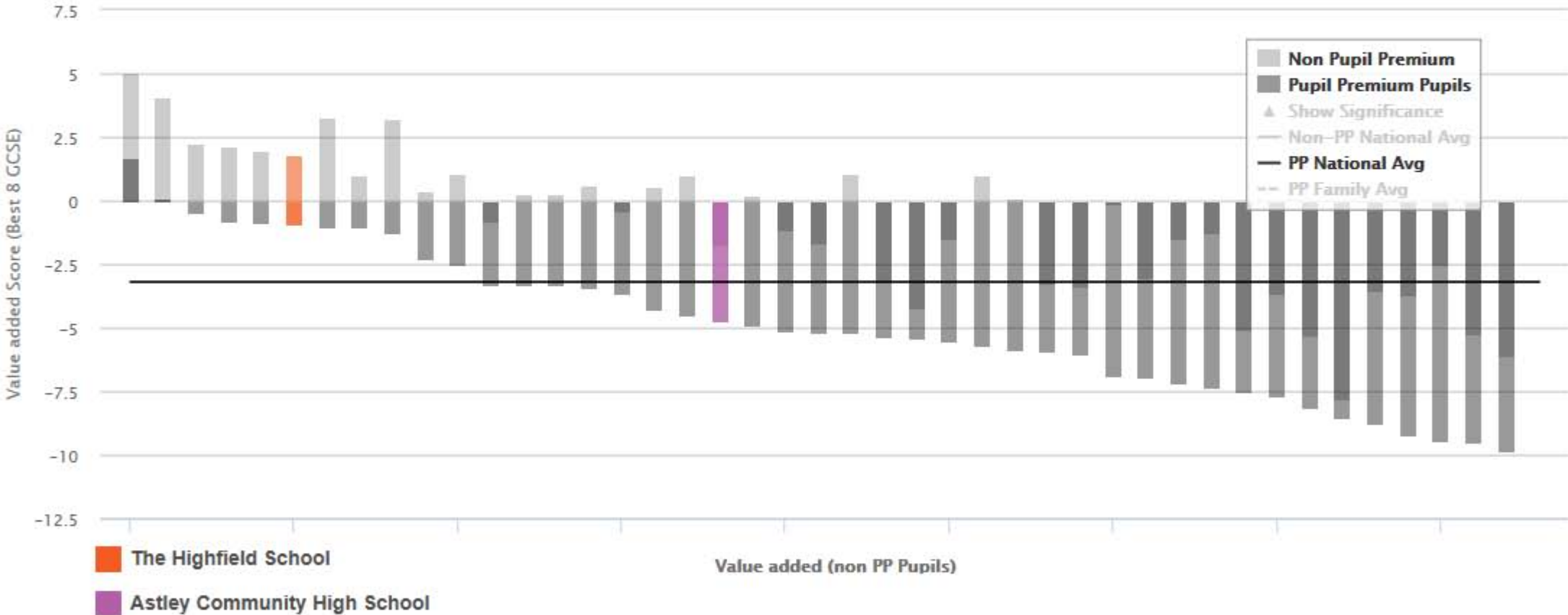

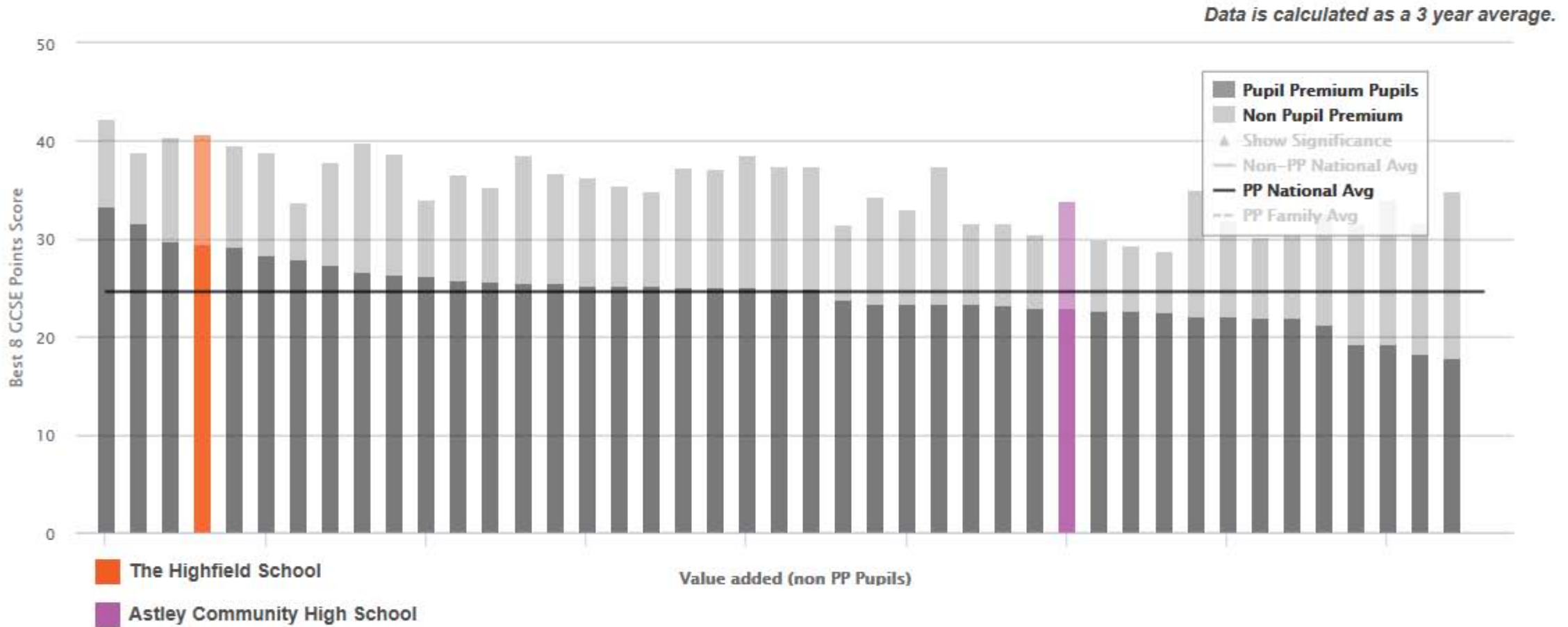

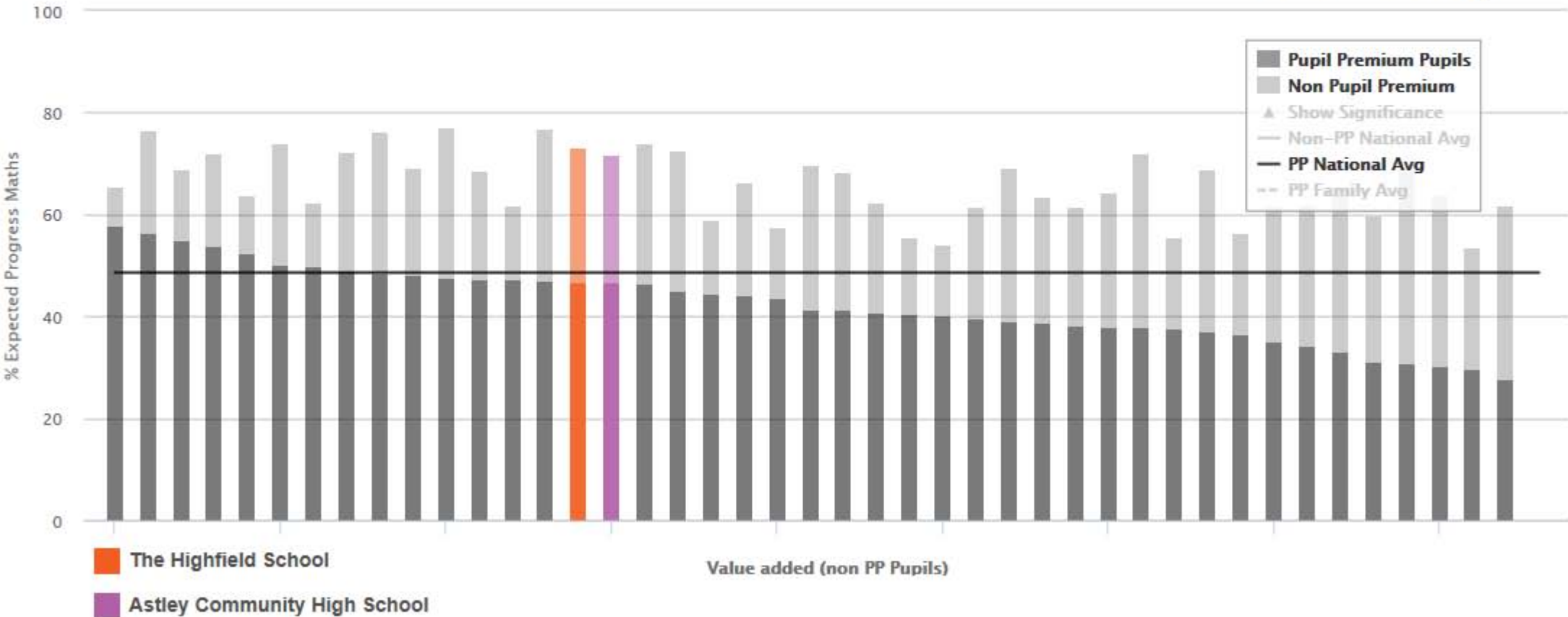

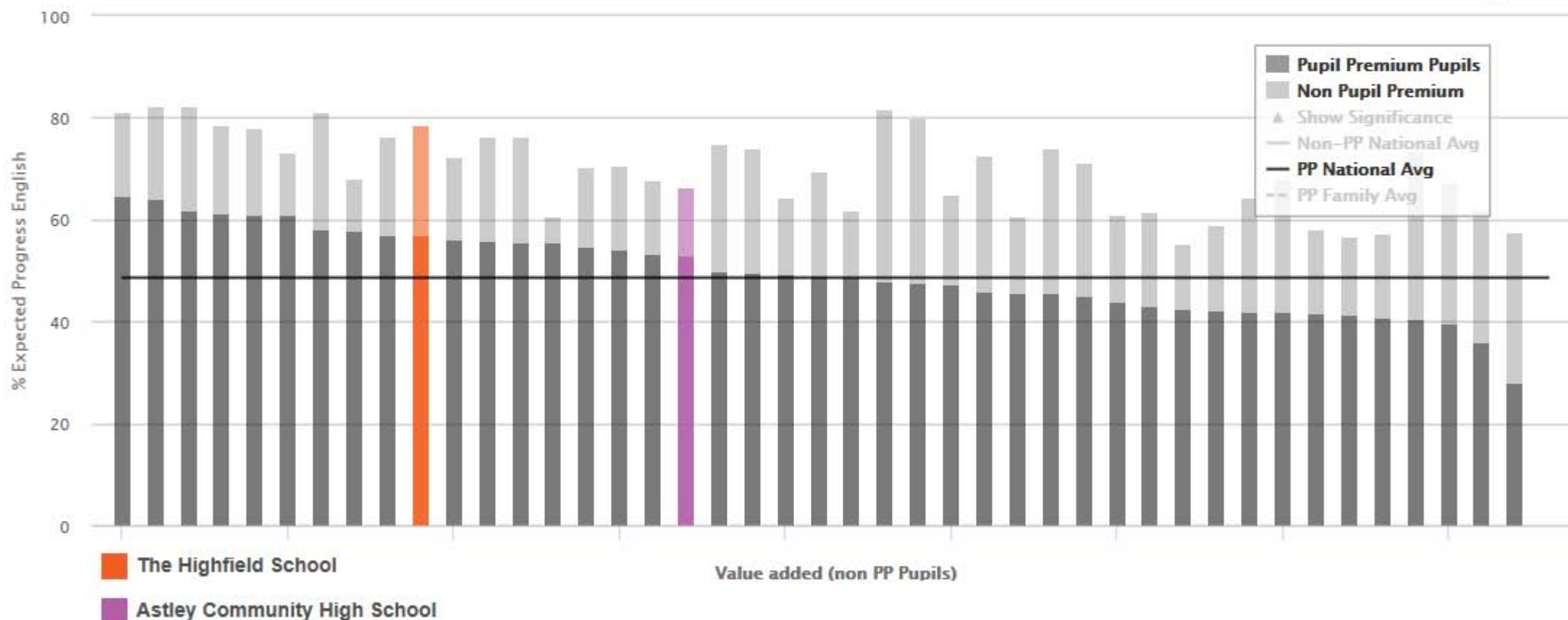
