



## **The 16 to 19 tuition fund**

### **2021 to 2022 academic year**

We have received funding from the government to help to support students in post-16 education who have been impacted by the lockdown and had their learning disrupted this year. The government requires the school to use this funding for students who did not reach a 4 or 5 at GCSE in English or Maths and are now studying A Level subjects, and for disadvantaged students. This will be used to support the students who this applies to.

The funding will be used for targeted support tuition for these students and will be used to support their current studies.

There will be 7 principles that will govern the tutorial sessions:

1. The groups will be small. No more than 5 students will be allocated to each group.
2. The sessions will be run by a subject specialist teacher or tutor.
3. The sessions may either have a subject specific knowledge, skills or broader academic focus to them.
4. The subjects chosen for tutoring will be subjects where the students are not making expected progress.
5. Tuition and additional support may be provided using a blend of on site and remote delivery.
6. Each session will be clearly planned with a topic or exam activity in mind so that it is as productive and targeted as possible.
7. Attendance and progress will be monitored.

### **Our Commitment**

The Highfield School is committed to ensuring the tuition fund is used in accordance with the Government's guidance on the 16 to 19 tuition fund by:

- Producing this statement explaining how we will use the funding in line with guidance to prioritise support for disadvantaged students.
- Publicising this statement on our website.

- Delivering the extra tuition and spend the associated funding in the 2021-2022 academic year.
